OKLAHOMA FACTS AND TRIVIA

Five Civilized Tribes Museum

In 1804, the area that would one day become Oklahoma was popularly known as the "Indian Territory." And so the United States government began relocating eastern Indian tribes to the Indian Territory to make room for western expansion.

"The Trail of Tears" is the name given to the relocation journey of the Five Civilized Tribes (Cherokee, Choctaw, Chickasaw, Creek and Seminole) from the southeastern United States to Oklahoma in the 1830's. The history of these tribes is re-told at the Five Civilized Tribes Museum in Muskogee. Housed in the old Union Indian Agency, the museum provides a clear look back at the tribes' taming of the land.

Governor's Message for January----- It's hard to believe it will be 2011 by the time you read this article. We won the Southwest Region points championship for the 10th straight season. The Southwest Region Awards Banquet is going to be held on March 12th at Texas Motor Speedway. I would like to see as many members there as possible to pick up our 10th straight championship award. This would not have been possible without each and every club member that competed in Southwest Region events, or helped out with timing, starting, staging, corners, timing board, results, registration, hospitality, technical inspection, etc.

We are currently in 3rd place nationally. All of the Southwest Region points have been included, but there are points for events in other regions that have not yet been included. This will make 8 years in a row that we have finished in the top 5 in the nation.

The first racing weekend will be April 2nd and 3rd in Houston. We will have playdays on March 5th, March 19th, March 26th, and May 14th at the Sheriff's track.

NCCC has changed insurance companies from K&K to Brown & Brown. The liability policy has gone from \$1 million to \$5 million for the same cost. This increase in liability will also prevent the club from having to purchase additional insurance when we host our drag events on Memorial Day Weekend.
